

Awards & their Criteria

For a student to qualify for any annual award, the following conditions should be met.

- Minimum of 90% attendance is maintained through the year.
- Practices all Islamic principles in day to day life.

Academic Excellence Award

- To be awarded annually to students for best performance in all subject areas in both Sem 1 and Sem 2. The awardee would have achieved at least 6 as IB grade in six subjects and the rest 5s.
- In case, if the teachers feel there is someone who missed out narrowly, could be recommended for Merit Certificate.
- Awardees to be decided for each year group (class)

Most Improved performer

- To be awarded annually to students for their perseverance and hard work to improve on their academic or non-academic areas that may or may not have resulted in best possible outcomes.
- Awarded for each year group

Community Service Award

- To be awarded annually to a student who has extended his/her contribution to members of the school community or outside of it resulting in significant outcome for individuals, organizations, or communities in problem solving or development.
- The categories are Grade 6,7 and 8 as one group and Grade 9 to 12 another.

Techno-proficiency Award

- To be awarded annually to students for innovative and creative use of technology in their learning and organizational processes. The recipient would not have used technology for any unethical practices.
- The categories are Grade 6,7 and 8 as one group and Grade 9 to 12 another.

IB Learner Profile Award

- To be awarded to a student who demonstrates Learner Profile Attributes that can inspire, motivate and focus the work of other students and unites them in a common purpose. The recipient would have a dynamic combination of knowledge, skills, independent, critical and creative thought and international mindedness, ready for a life of active, responsible citizenship.
- The categories are Grade 6,7 and 8 as one group and Grade 9 to 12 another.

Public Speaking Award

- To be awarded annually to students for their public speaking ability demonstrated through the year on formal occasions. The candidate is expected to have participated in at least three formal events as a lead speaker.
- The categories are Grade 6,7 and 8 as one group and Grade 9 to 12 another.

Chairman's award

It will be awarded in three categories:

1 Primary

1 in MYP

and 1 for an Outgoing graduating student.

Criteria for qualifying CHAIRMAN'S AWARD

- a. 100% Attendance & Proactive Fee Clearance
- b. No Discipline infringements
- c. The family extends complete cooperation to School's initiatives, systems and policies.
- d. Minimum academic achievement of 6 or A grade in all subjects in both semesters

- e. Exemplary Islamic behavior (This will be established in staff meeting on nominations); To be confirmed by extensively interviewing both the patents at the time of nomination.
- f. Exceeding Expectations in Islamic Studies Curriculum
- g. Interview by a Committee
- h. Should have initiated at least one Community project
- i. Should have achieved minimum of 70th percentile in both exams of ACER IBT
